*Ed: England Athletics, the new governing body for all athletics as from next year is set to get ongoing publicity about how much better things will be. We don't all believe it, and I asked secretary Bert Norburn to give us some background:*

### Club in dispute with North of England AA over membership payments.

I know that most athletes have no interest in the administration of our sport but allow me to outline to you what is going to happen and what has already happened with membership scheme payments that you have made.

In 2000 the NoEAA introduced a membership scheme and decided upon an initial cost of £1 per athlete. Clubs were informed that the purpose of the scheme was to establish what participation there was in our sport and to pay £30,000 towards the Salary's of the three newly introduced RDC's in our area. £60,000 came from other sources to fund the RDC's.

The membership scheme originally collected just over the £30,000 required. There were admin costs to register data and produce membership cards. The scheme charge was quickly put up to £2 for each athlete.

At the beginning of 2006 the NoEAA published a newsletter describing amongst other matters how the membership scheme would still be administered this year by them as the new governing body England Athletics were not in a position to introduce the scheme. I quickly realised that there were NO RDC's to fund in the North and asked the North why they were continuing to collect money from athletes. I found to my horror that not only is every penny from the membership scheme collected this year minus admin costs going straight into the coffers of the North of England (estimated at £60,000 plus) but in 2005 NONE of the membership money from YOU THE ATHLETES WAS SPENT ON RDC's salary it went straight into the coffers of the North of England. The Club has exchanged letters with the NoEAA and they have laid the blame for the message not going out to club members because delegates from Clubs and County Associations

failed to circulate the decision ( no mention of the decision in newsletters or on their web site).

The NoEAA have failed to identify when the decision to keep the 2005 membership scheme proceeds was made and by whom. Your executive committee believe that the NoEAA have acted without authority in diverting the funds because it was such a massive change that clubs should have been consulted. We have requested refund of some of the monies taken from YOU THE ATHLETES. I have just spent the last 4 hours formulating our registration of members list and North of England Affiliation documents to allow us to compete in this coming season.

Your Club has to pay £768 to the North. We have disputed their authority to request the £2 membership fee because a proportion of it (estimated at almost 50%) is in fact a donation to the funds of the North of England. It is the view of your executive committee that donations should be voluntary and they should not be allowed to demand such donations. We have requested the right to seek a refund from the North of England but have paid up front to allow members of our club to participate in our sport.

I will keep you informed of developments.....

In closing however I must warn you that in April 2007 our new governing body England Athletics will introduce a National Membership Scheme. This is in spite of the fact that Clubs in a AAA's of England voted overwhelmingly against such a scheme (democracy in action). We have received reliable information that the cost of the National Membership scheme in April 2007 will be athletes over 11 years of age £5 per year, athletes under 11 years £2.50. This means that your club will have to recover over £1400 from our members. At the moment the Scottish National membership stands at £15.

## Relays

AAA 12 Stage (men) and 6 Stage (women) Road Relays, Sutton Park, Saturday April 8th 2006

## Mens event

Rotherham Harriers men produced a stirring performance at a windy Sutton Park to record our finish at the AAA 12 Stage Road Relays for several years. Having qualified in 9th place at the recent Northern 12 Stage event at Heaton Park, Manchester, the squad were then seriously depleted by the withdrawals of several of the athletes from the qualifying team. Nevertheless, the considerable team management efforts of Peter Neal and Pete Shaw ensured that the team arrived at Sutton Park with a full compliment of athletes. Windy conditions and, for the latter stages, driving rain, made the going tough for the athletes on the alternating long (5.4 miles) and short (3 miles) legs.

The details of times and positions are shown in the table below, but the key factor of the day has to be the sheer commitment of the whole team. In recent years, call offs such as we experienced prior to the event would have meant our team not taking part, but such is the feeling in the mens squad now that we were going to move heaven and earth to be there and to finish a complete team. The ethos is now one of **WE WILL BE THERE and WE WILL FINISH** at major road relays. This attitude has served us well in events over the past year, and indeed we were the only team from South Yorkshire to finish a team, with fellow qualifiers Hallamshire only able to field two athletes. Indeed, we were the third Yorkshire team to finish, behind 4th placed Leeds City, and York Acorn. With a team effort such as this it is impossible to single out any one athlete for praise, as each gave 100% on behalf of the club.

## Ladies event

The ladies were unable to field a complete team but nevertheless Jenny Blizard, Joanne Walker and Sue Bellamy were prepared to make the trip and show a presence from Rotherham harriers in the ladies event. Once again Jenny showed her top form in finishing 4th on the first leg, with a time of 16 minutes 44 seconds for the undulating 3 mile course, a time just outside the top 10 fastest overall on the day. Joanne Walker then took over and battled hard to come home in 7th place, with a time of 18 minutes 16 seconds. On leg 3 Sue Bellamy overcame the effects of a cold to bring us home in 27th place with a time of 21 minutes 35 seconds.

Hopefully the efforts of the 3 athletes who took part will inspire other at the club and the ladies will surely emulate the men in maintaining a proud record of participation in major road relay events in the near future.

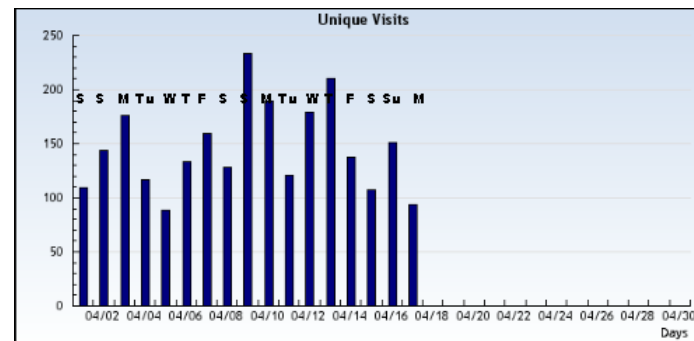
